This refers to your request under the *Access to Information Act* dated July 11, 2006, to obtain information pertaining to access to information regarding the 1978-1980 RCMP investigation into the Canadian blood broker Continental Pharma Cryosan Ltd.

Unfortunately, we are unable to comply with your request as we are bound by the provisions of the Act which restricts the right of access to Canadian citizens, a permanent resident within the meaning of the Immigration Act and all individuals present in Canada. In the case of the Access to Information Act, access is also extended to all corporations that are present in Canada.

Should you be a Canadian citizen, we will be pleased to process your request. Kindly resubmit your request application with proof of citizenship to this office. Ensure your application fee of \$5.00, payable by cheque or money order to the Receiver General of Canada, is included.
